

GUARDING AGAINST SINN FEIN REVOLT

Precautions to Meet Possible Easter Outbreak Taken in Ireland

KEEP WATCH ON TRAVELERS

By the Associated Press. London, April 3.—Reports from many parts of Ireland indicate that the government is taking no chances of a possible materialization of the rumored Sinn Fein plot for an Easter revolution.

Elaborate preparations are being made to handle any possible outbreak of violence. Thus far, however, all newspaper reports from Ireland declare there is no Sinn Fein plot and that no uprising is expected.

There was great military activity in the suburbs of Dublin today, according to a dispatch. Parties of soldiers with armoured cars took up positions shortly after midnight just outside the city and all vehicles approaching the capital were searched.

Constantinople, April 3.—(By A. P.)—In addition to pronounced military activity in the vicinity of Londonderry today, all the roads being patrolled, the passengers who arrived by the Scotch boat at Londonderry were searched by the police.

Limerick, April 3.—(By A. P.)—Numerous arrests were made early today by the military and many houses were searched. The reason for the actions of the military are unknown.

FATAL DUEL STIRS URUGUAY

Political Excitement Follows Slaying of Former President. Montevideo, Uruguay, April 3.—(By A. P.)—Political excitement prevailed in this city as a result of the death of Washington Boltran, editor of the newspaper El Pais, in a duel with former President Jose Batlle y Ordoñez, yesterday.

After the last elections in Uruguay the Nationalists accused the "Batlistes," the party headed by the former president, of fraud. Boltran's newspaper called Batlle the "Champion of Fraud."

The opponents met on a football field in the midst of a pouring rainstorm. Standing twenty-five paces apart, the shotless Boltran fired the word to fire, both missing on the first exchange.

Boishevists Defeated in Region of Lepel. Headquarters Announces. Warsaw, April 3.—(By A. P.)—Russian Bolshevik forces attacked the Polish lines in the region of Lepel, east of Vilna and north of Borisov, on Thursday, but were repulsed, according to an official statement issued at army headquarters here.

Constantinople, April 3.—(By A. P.)—Vindikavaz, an important military station and trading center in Caucasus, has been captured by the Bolsheviks, according to dispatches received here.

200 CHINESE TROOPS SLAIN. Many Also Wounded During Mutiny in Anhui Province. Amoy, China, April 3.—(By A. P.)—Two hundred soldiers were killed and many wounded in a mutiny of troops in Anhui province, according to dispatches received here.

Trieste, 3 aprile.—Il capo di Gabinetto di Gabriele D'Annunzio ha dichiarato che la proclamazione di Fiume come Stato indipendente, non significa rinuncia all'Annessione all'Italia.

Roma, 3 aprile.—Nuove restrizioni sul consumo della carne, pane, riso e zucchero sono state annunciate, oggi, in un decreto emesso dal Governo. La consumazione della carne e' proibita nei giorni di giovedì e venerdì.

Ginevra, 2 aprile.—Il Deputato Rodani ha dichiarato che le relazioni diplomatiche tra l'Italia e la Russia appartengono al partito socialista e fa parte di una commissione di dodici, compresi i delegati delle cooperative italiane e del partito socialista, la quale si recherà in Russia verso la fine di aprile.

La Commissione e' ufficialmente istituita dal Governo Italiano sul compito di ristabilire le relazioni diplomatiche e commerciali con Lening. Tale misura rappresenta una importante concessione del governo verso i socialisti, ma e' evidente che non li pacifichera'.

LA PRENSA FLOUTS DIPLOMACY OF U. S.

Argentine Newspapers Call Washington Notes to S. American Nations Innocuous

Buenos Aires, April 3.—Recent Argentine notes to Chile, Bolivia and Peru are described as "the fruit of diplomatic inexperience" by La Prensa, which declares they "do not reveal any political plan that should alarm the South American continent or give Argentina any motive for suspicion."

In its first editorial on the subject the newspaper asked whether the notes, "which affect the sovereignty of those states, respond to a resolved policy according to which the United States constitutes itself the inherent protector of new world republics," and "What should be the attitude of Argentina?"

These questions are answered today, the journal stating it has a "profound knowledge of the functioning of the American State Department, and asserting that department 'never cultivated a diplomatic modus vivendi' and does not possess a diplomacy."
