

NOYES SORRY FOR WOMAN ASSAILANT

Author Says Position of Mrs. Newman, Sister of Casement, Is Pitiful

FALSIFIER, SHE CHARGES

Alfred Noyes, English poet and writer, today expressed nothing but sympathy for the sister of Sir Robert Casement, executed Irish leader, who assailed him as a "dastard" and "despicable coward" last night.

Statement by Mrs. Newman

Mrs. Newman made a statement this afternoon in which she said in part:

"When Alfred Noyes stated that he

said nothing reflecting on my brother's character after his death he falsified the truth, just as he falsified it when he wrote that infamous article which appeared in a legal paper of August 31, 1916. Twenty-eight days after my brother was executed in Pentonville Prison, London, Alfred Noyes wrote and published an article headed 'Revelation of Casement's Diaries.' ...
