DENY HARD COAL MINERS' UNREST

Union Leaders Affirm Ability to Copé With Situation in Anthracite Region

NEW SCALE BEING SHAPED

New York, April 15.—Dissatisfaction and unrest among the anthracite mine workers due to the slow progress being made in the wage negotiations are not serious and district officials will cope with the situation, union leaders announced here today after a conference

with the miners' general scale committee. The workers' representatives on the subcommittee appointed to make the new contract reported to the scale committee that progress was being made as fast as the situation would permit. They reviewed the history of the negotiations to date and urged the men to be patient until the proceedings were completed. District officers and board members were instructed to keep the miners in the field at work at all costs and carry out the retroactive agreement made with the operators. "We do not regard the reported unrest in the anthracite fields as serious," said Thomas Kennedy, president of District No. 7, with headquarters at Hazleton. "Last night about 1500 men from one colliery in my district by a unanimous vote decided to continue at work pending the outcome of the negotiations. I believe that is indicative of the spirit of the men. There is no cause for alarm that I can see at this time." Christ Golden, president of district No. 9, with headquarters at Shamokin, said he was without official information today from his territory, where about 15,000 mine workers had threatened to

quit work. He said he believed they would remain at work.
