Il Concilio di San Remo Sente l'Opinione degli Esperti Militari

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San Remo, 22 aprile.—Il Supremo Concilio Alleato, dopo la riunione di

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stamane, ha emesso il seguente comunicato ufficiale: "Il Supremo Concilio, riunito alle ore 11 di stamane, ha inteso l'opinione degli esperti militari e navali sulla questione riguardante l'amministrazione del Dardanelli. Il Concilio approva l'inscrizione di una ciurma al riguardo nel trattato di pace con la Turchia. Il Concilio inoltre ha preso in esame la presente situazione nel Caucaso. La discussione di quanto dovrà essere

richiesto alla Germania relativamente all'osservanza dei termini del trattato di Versailles, avverrà" quanto prima. Al riguardo si dice che la tensione tra la Delegazione francese e quella inglese è considerevole. I francesi dichiarano che sono gravemente danneggiati dal fatto che la Germania non ha adempiuto alle obbligazioni stabilite nel trattato di pace, specialmente per aver trattato il materiale di guerra, obbligando così la Francia a rimanere armata e

che la riduzione dell'invio di carbone ostacola le sue principali industrie. Parigi 22 aprile.—Il corrispondente del "Matin" da San Remo telegrafica di essere stato informato che l'atteggiamento dei Primi Ministri d'Italia e Inghilterra, riguardo la Germania, potrà culminare a suggerire che un rappresentante del governo tedesco sia invitato ad intervenire alla Conferenza. I Primi Ministri analizzati ritengono che la presenza del cancelliere germanico

potrebbe essere desiderabile per discutere le future relazioni economiche con la Germania e che la produzione degli ex-nemici darebbe migliori risultati. Il corrispondente dice che Millerand è convinto che i suoi colleghi abbiano preso una via sbagliata. Il Supremo Concilio ha abbandonato l'idea di dare un mandato per l'Armenia alla Lega delle Nazioni, come risultato delle eccezioni sorte in seno al Concilio della Lega stessa, e chiederà alla Svezia e Norvegia di aiutare il popolo ar-

meno, nello stabilire un libero Stato, salvo a provvedere alle sue finanze con un prestito internazionale. Il Primo Ministro di Francia, Millerand, ha ricevuto a San Remo un giornalista americano al quale avrebbe parlato molto liberamente riguardo gli affari della Conferenza della Pace. In tale occasione avrebbe osservato che l'amicizia tra la Francia e gli Stati Uniti non incominciò nel 1914, ma parecchio tempo prima, ed espresse il suo rammarico di non vedere una di-

retta ed attiva cooperazione da parte del Governo degli Stati Uniti per la preparazione del trattato di pace con la Turchia. Bala-Cynwyd Players in Benefit.
