

HOOVER PROTECTED GIRL FROM A "MASHER" HERE

Station Lounger Didn't Know Stalwart Man Was Famous Presidential Possibility, but Hagerstown Miss Did

Herbert Hoover came to the rescue of a pretty Hagerstown, Md., girl when she was accosted rudely recently in Broad Street Station by a young man, Miss Eleanor G. Mish, daughter of State Senator and Mrs. Frank W. Mish, of Prospect street, Hagerstown, told the story of Mr. Hoover's opportune gallantry in a letter to a friend at Hagerstown.

The incident occurred during the recent walkout of railroad employees. Miss Mish was waiting at Broad Street Station for a New York train to return to school at Plainfield, N. J. Several persons near Miss Mish said there would be no trains to New York until the next morning and suggested that he would be glad to take her to a hotel.

A man was sitting near Miss Mish. He suddenly arose, dismissed the

"guide" with a few words spoken to him aside, and then assured Miss Mish that there would be a train for New York in a short time.

"I'm going there myself," the man said.

Later he put the girl on the train and accompanied her as far as Newark, where she changed cars for Plainfield. "I'm Herbert Hoover," the man said, as the girl extended her hand in parting.

"I thought you were," said the girl. "You look just like your pictures. I hope I get a chance to vote for you."

HEIR OF SLAVE MAMMY

Lion Tamer Inherits From Woman Grandfather Owned

A lion tamer with a circus, grandson of a southern planter and slave-owner, is the beneficiary under the will of Mrs. Mary Waters, one of his grandfather's slaves.

The lion tamer is George E. Newcomb, twenty-three years old. He appeared before Register of Wills Sheehan yesterday, when the will was produced. The aged woman died December 27, 1919, at 3 Butler's avenue, in the house she has lived in since the Civil War. The will was written on the back page of an old polyglot Bible, printed in 1844.

As Mrs. Waters could not write the will had been written and witnessed by Mary E. Crawford, a negro, living at 628 North Thirty-eighth street. Mrs. Crawford was brought to the office, and as her handwriting was found to correspond, the will was declared valid and

admitted to probate. Several letters of administration in the estate that had been granted at the request of creditors were canceled.

Mr. Newcomb said his father was John L. Newcomb, son of the slave-owner, and his mother was Eugenia L. Newcomb. They came to this city and met with various misfortunes, finally dying, and the child was raised by Mrs. Waters, being admitted to Girard College when seven years old. Mr. Newcomb said his old "mammy" was the only mother he had ever known.

Cook Drowns, Wife Saved
Earl Middleton, cook on the tugboat Curtin, was drowned when he fell overboard yesterday. His wife, who had come to visit him from Savannah, was dragged overboard by Middleton in his efforts to save himself. She was rescued and taken to the Cooper Hospital. The Curtin was tied up at the Noecker & Ake Shipbuilding Co.'s ship repair plant in Camden when the accident happened.

Wed 43 Years, Asks Divorce
William H. Hullings and his wife, of Gloucester City, may be divorced after having been married forty-three years. The husband is seventy years old and the wife sixty years. She declares she has been ill-treated for years, finally

having been deserted. A divorce has been recommended by former Judge Bayle, sitting as advisory master. The couple have several children.
