It Only Way to Restore **Normal Conditions**

SCORES WILSON'S POLICY TO EXTEND FOREIGN WORK

Washington, May 13.-A status of peace must be obtained "in some other way" if it cannot be secured by ratifiation of the treaty and the League of Nations, Senator Kellogg, one of the original "mild reservation" Republicans, declared today in the Senate, supporting the Republican peace resolu-

"It is of the utmost importance," he aid, "that a status of peace be accomolished. Not only is it necessary to the adostries of this country and its trade. or it is important that the war powers

of the President should cease." He declared that President Wilson made ratification impossible and that the peace resolution offers the only vay to restore normal conditions. President has iterated and re

ate abrogate its functions and accept the trenty exactly as it was presented to this country through foreign powers," Senator Kellogg continued. "The issue is thus reached, shall we adopt the league and the treaty, imperiling Amercentive, or shall we adopt the treaty with reservations, protecting American rights, American interests and Amer-ican aspirations?"

Kellogg expressed confidence in the effectiveness of the resolution to acnlish its ends.

"Mild Reservationist" Believes Three Others Now Serving as Missionary Leaders Will Be Elevated

By the Associated Press Des Moines, Ia., May 13.—Election of fourteen new bishops was called for in the report of the committee on episcopacy presented today to the Metho-dist Episcopal conference. In addi-tion three men at present missionary bishops will be raised to the full general superintendency, making seventeen in all—the largest number ever bal-loted upon.

The report recommends seven new residences, Indianapolis, Shanghai, Calcutta, Singapore, Mexico City, Paris and Copenhagen. In addition there are also seven bishops to be elected to fill existing vacancies. Those in the United States to be filled are at Portland, Ore.; Helena, Mont., and Pittsburgh. Those abroad are Pekin, Manila, Bangalore, India and Monrovia, Liberia.

The seat of one episcopal area is recommended to be changed in Africa. Up to this time it has been at Umtali, Rhodesja, and Cape Town, South Africa, is

If the report of the committee is adopted it will mean that additions will be made in the foreign field as follows: China, three bishops instead of two; Southern Asia, four bishops instead of two; Latin America and South America, two bishops instead of one; Europe, three bishops instead of one.

The three missionary bishops who will be raised to bishops are Frank W. Warne, of Lucknow, India; John W. Robinson, of Bombay, Iudia, and Eben S. Johnson, of Africa.
