## WOMEN GOLFERS BATTLE IN RAIN

Play Begins at Overbrook for Geist Trophy—Mrs. Barlow Favorite

EIGHTY-EIGHT ENTERED

Overbrook Golf Club, Overbrook, Pa., May 14.—When Miss N. Halliwell, of St. David's, and Miss Mary Griffith, of Merion, drove off from the first tee this morning in the handicap medal golf match for the Clarence H. Geist cup, rain was coming down steadily. This, however, did not prevent the large majority of entrants from showing up at the time when they were scheduled to begin.

The greens and fairways were slow, but the women did well during the early hours of play in spite of the boggy condition of the course. They were scheduled to play eighteen holes.

Although Mrs. Barlow was the favorite, other star golfers of Philadelphia had big followings. There were a half dozen or more who were considered to have better than a fighting chance of landing this coveted trophy today. Among them were Mrs. Celeb Fox, five times Philadelphia champion; Mrs. G. Henry Stetson, of Huntingdon Valley, who recently won the tournament at Bellair, Pa.; Miss Eleanor T. Chandler, Huntingdon Valley.

The only prominent women players who are not entered in the tournament are Mrs. C. H. Vandenberg and Miss Mildred Caverly, both of whom are at New Castle, County Down, Ireland, where they were defeated in the match
