

BUYS 4 BIG SHIPS WITH \$50 IN BANK

He Put Through With Charles W. Morse

Government Blocked Sale

New York, May 14.—With a bank account of \$10 and unlimited confidence in his ability to get hundreds of thousands more, E. A. Moulton, of New Rochelle, a \$50-a-week employe of a steamship firm, last night started the congressional committee investigating the relations of the Morse interests with the United States shipping board with a recital of how he negotiated with Charles W. Morse in an attempted purchase of four steamships valued at \$50,000 each.

Moulton said he intended to purchase the Huron, St. Paul, Binghamton and Minneapolis from the United States Steamship Co., and that he gave Charles W. Morse, head of the company, personal checks for \$340,000 toward the purchase. The checks were dated in advance.

Reminded by Representative Tom Connally, of Texas, that he had previously admitted having only \$10 in a New Rochelle bank, Moulton said he intended to put the money up to cover the checks.

"This was all a moonshine proposition," Connally said. "No, I could have got the money," Moulton replied.

Moulton said the deal collapsed when the United States Government refused to transfer the ships to Canadian registry, and that Mr. Morse released him from his obligation and he in turn released a release.

"Swapped releases," Representative Connally suggested.
