

GEDDES HAS SMILE FOR PICKETS HERE

Ambassador, in City to Receive Medal for Countryman, Tolerates Irish Demonstration

PLACARDS ATTACK "ARMY"

Six young women pickets, urging the cause of Irish freedom, were among others who greeted Sir Auckland Geddes, British ambassador to the United States, when he arrived at the Franklin Institute to accept a medal in behalf of a fellow countryman.

On placards carried by the pickets was the following message: "Geddes, American woman demand that England withdraw her army of occupation from Ireland."

Sir Auckland, who was accompanied by Paul Lagerberg, secretary of the Swedish legation, and others, passed the pickets with a smile and entered the building without comment.

Heading the pickets were Mrs. Stevens Harbison, of Buffalo; Miss Phyllis Soden, Forty-eighth street; and Westminster woman, and Miss Rita McCarty, 336 North Forty-eighth street.

A limousine arrived shortly afterward. It was the British ambassador and Mr. Lagerberg, secretary of the Swedish legation, and several officers of the institute. The pickets came to present arms with their placards and flags—the occupants of the car smiled and passed into the building.

Medals for Scientists Presented
Dr. Walton Clark presided at the meeting at which Franklin medals were presented to Sir Auckland and Mr. Lagerberg for Sir Charles A. Parsons, of Newcastle-on-Tyne, England, and

Prof. Svante August Arrhenius, of Stockholm, Sweden. The Swedish minister was unable to be present on account of illness.
Sir Charles Parsons's award was given him as a tribute to his work in developing the steam turbine engine. He has also made valuable contributions and inventions along other lines in physical science, among them being improvements in gramophones and investigations on the formation of diamonds. He is a fellow of the Royal Society.
After speaking of the honor he felt in receiving the medal on behalf of his countrymen, Sir Auckland said that the institute had shown that its outlook extended beyond national boundaries.

NAVY PAY INCREASE AID TO RECRUITING

Attractive Provisions Are Made for Ex-Service Men Who Want to Re-enlist

TRANSPORTATION FOR WIVES

Officers of the navy recruiting station at 1515 Arch street today announced the direct benefits to enlisted men of the navy through the signing yesterday by the President of the navy pay increase bill.

Immediate stimulus to recruiting, particularly in the re-enlistment of former service men, is expected as a result of the new increase.

One of the most attractive provisions of the new act is that all ex-service men who have not been out of the navy more than one year may now return and receive all benefits of continuous service pay and honorable discharge gratuity, which formerly were allowed only if men re-enlisted within

four months. This is in effect until November 19.
Naval reserves having one year or more to serve in the naval reserve force may transfer to the regular service for the remainder of their reserve enlistment and receive thirty days' leave and four months' discharge gratuity, and an increase of seven dollars a month over the new base pay.
