Rowdies and Police Clash in Rome During War Celebration Rome, May 25.—(By A. P.)—Four policemen and one civilian were killed in a clash between rowdies and police during a demonstration celebrating the fifth anniversary of Italy's entry into the world war here yesterday. About 300 students gathered in Via Nazionale and the police were endeavoring to disperse them when persons believed not to have been students, but disorderly elements, fired several shots, which were returned by the police.

Wounded Policeman Shoots Prisoner He Had Released California, May 25.—(By A. P.)—John Kaytown was killed and E. W. Miller, a policeman, was seriously wounded last night in a pistol duel at Danstown, near here. Miller, it is alleged, had placed Kaytown under arrest, but, due to the pleadings of the man's wife, released him. As soon as he was out of reach of the officer Kaytown is said to have drawn a revolver and opened fire on Miller. After being wounded Miller fired at Kaytown, killing him instantly.
