New York, May 28.—(By A. P.)—
Miss Maria Tucci, aged twenty, tried on a charge of first degree murder for the shooting of her sister. Mrs. Angelina. Conti, on March 8, was found guilty night of manslaughter in the first degree.

Sentence will be imposed June 7.

The shooting occurred in an East Side apartment in which the sisters resided. The prosecution alleged that the shots were fired by Miss Tucci after her sister had retired for the night. The defense claimed the shooting was in self-defense. The law provides a penalty of ten to twenty years' imprisonment for conviction of manslaughter in the first degree.

Approximately 4700 persons are employed at the mill and all of these with the exception of 300 clerks, carpenters and like employes, either joined the strike or were forced out of work by the closing of the plant.
