Roma, 8 giugno.—Da fonte autorevole si apprende che, in seguito alla vive premure del Governo Italiano, i Primi Ministri di Francia ed Inghilterra avrebbero acconsentito che il convegno di Spa, al quale dovranno essere presenti i delegati della Germania, e' stato rinviato.  
Dicesi che la data sara' fissata per non prima del 15 luglio prossimo. In-

tanto si annunzia che un incontro tra due primi ministri predetti avra' luogo fra giorni a Boulogne, allo scopo di discutere le garanzie per la futura esecuzione del trattato di pace con la Germania, l'esecuzione delle clausole del trattato stesso, il disarmo e le penalita' da infliggersi alla Germania.  
Oggi a Genova, nel palazzo reale, avra' luogo la prima seduta della Conferenza Internazionale del Lavoro. I delegati esteri sono tutti arrivati, ricevuti dalle autorita' italiane. In onore di essi il Sindaco di Genova

dara' un ricevimento nel palazzo municipale.  
Un dispaccio da Londra annunzia che colà e' giunto il Conte Carlo Sforza, sotto segretario di Stato al Ministero per gli Affari Esteri, il quale sembra dover conferire con la Commissione delle riparazioni per la questione della divisione di dette riparazioni dovute dalla Germania.  
Papa Benedetto e' sofferente per un attacco di reumatismo. Inoltre una leggera indisposizione si verifico' nel Santo Padre in conseguenza della fatica per la

cerimonia della beatificazione di 22 negri, martiri di Uganda. La notte scorsa, pero, la passo' calmosissima ed i medici stamani hanno riscontrato un notevole miglioramento nelle condizioni generali di lui.  
Parigi, 8 giugno.—Le comunicazioni telefoniche e telegrafiche tra l'Italia e la Francia sono interrotte da questa mattina.
