Plan Informal Discussions of Relations With United States Washington, June 12.—(By A. P.) Reports have reached the State De-

partment through unofficial channels that the new Mexican government is about to send to the United States a mission to discuss the United States a on to discuss the relations between the two countries in an entirely in-formal way. Miguel Covorrubias, the dean of Mexican diplomats, and Ferindo Iglesia Calderon, a historian of note, are mentioned as attending the mission. The mission will not have plenary powers, but it is the desire of the Mex-tean government, seconding can government, according to reports, that it determine a basis for the adjustment of all the differences between the two countries. Members of the mission intend to confer with leading members of the Senate and House and officials of the administration to discuss the formation of an international claims commission as well as some of the legislation of Mexico against which the United States has protested.

Calderon is one of the most prominent "intellectuals" in Mexico and is said to be the only Mexican private citizen ever received by President Wilson in the White House.
