Local Singing Society Gives Excellent Concert With the Victor Herbert Orchestra

The Mendelssohn Club, under the direction of the conductor, N. Lindsay Norden, gave an excellent concert last evening at Willow Grove, being assisted by the Victor Herbert Orchestra. In this part the general work of the club was of even better quality than in the first.

The unfavorable weather affected not only the attendance, but the carrying power of the voices of the chorus, and it speaks volumes for the ability of the Mendelssohn Club that it was able to give a concert of the high standard of last evening's under such unfavorable conditions. It is to be hoped that the organization will appear at the grove again this season when the weather-gods will be more propitious.
