

**MENDELSSOHN CLUB
AT WILLOW GROVE**

Local Singing Society Gives Excellent Concert With the Victor Herbert Orchestra

The Mendelssohn Club, under the direction of the conductor, N. Lindsay Norden, gave an excellent concert last evening at Willow Grove, being assisted by the Victor Herbert Orchestra. The rainy weather naturally had a bad effect upon the attendance, both of the chorus and of the audience, although fully three-quarters of the club took part in the performance.

The club sang twice, giving five numbers the first appearance and four in the concert after the intermission. They appeared first in the club motto, the words and music of which are by the late Dr. W. W. Gilchrist, for many years the director of the organization. This they sang with orchestral accompaniment, the orchestration being effectively arranged by Mr. Norden. The last then sang Blumenthal's sprightly "Gather Ye Rosebuds While Ye May,"

Grieg's "Ave Maria Stella," Rimsky-Korsakoff's "Song of India," the tenor solo part being well taken by Charles M. Stahl, and the Mendelssohn Club prize composition, "De Sinterbol," by W. W. Webbe.

The club was palpably unaccustomed to out-of-door singing, but after the first number or two the training which it has had under Mr. Norden began to assert itself and the balance steadily improved in each succeeding number. In other respects, such as the attack, the vocal color and various details, there was little difference between the performance last evening and their work during the past season.

After the intermission the club again appeared, this time in four numbers, Twelzykoff's solemn "Oh, Shine Forth New Jerusalem," Brewer's humorous "Alexander" and Dickinson's "Nymph and Swain." In this part the general work of the club was of even better quality than in the first.

The unfavorable weather affected not only the attendance, but the carrying power of the voices of the chorus, and it speaks volumes for the ability of the Mendelssohn Club that it was able to give a concert of the high standard of last evening's under such unfavorable conditions. It is to be hoped that the organization will appear at the grove again this season when the weather-gods will be more propitious.
