

BOY HIT BY AUTO DIES OF INJURIES

Grief-Stricken Father Attacks Geo. W. Elkins, Jr., Believing His Machine Hit Son

YOUTH DROVE DEATH CAR

George W. Pennell, nine years old, of Rydal, died late last night in the Abington Hospital as the result of injuries received when struck by an automobile.

When informed his son was dying, Robert Pennell the father, tried to attack George W. Elkins, Jr., president of the board of trustees of the hospital, in the belief that Mr. Elkins was the driver of the car in the accident.

Hospital attendants restrained the grief-stricken parent. The boy died a short time after the attempted assault. Winston Kint, eighteen-year-old son of Charles Kint, a member of the firm of the John C. Winston Publishing Co., drove the automobile.

The Abington Hospital suffering from internal injuries and fractured legs. Two persons were injured in motorcycle accidents on the Roosevelt boulevard last night.
