## **MEXICO WRESTLES** WITH NEW REVOLT

Minor Outbreaks Reported Coahuila: Also Between Tampico and Monterey

Consul Blocker at Piedra Regras telegraphed that General Ricardo Gonzales, a nephew of General Pablo Gonzales, with a force estimated at between 50 and 200 men, had revolted against the present government, cutting the lines south of Monclova, Coahuila, on July 4, and advancing as far north of Berroterran, where they are now located holding coal mines. Federal General Morales left Piedras Negras last night with 200 soldiers to attack the revolting force. Another federal column is reported to be advancing from Saltillo.

Advices from the American consul at Tampico stated that it was officially ac-knowledged there that General Carlos Osuna and General Larrabee Agadir were in rebellion. General Osuna is reorted to be between Tampico and Monerey and General Agadir on the San

There also were reports at Piedras Negras that General Jesus Guajardo bad revolted at Gomez Palacio, near Torreon, with 300 men, and had advanced toward the American border over the old Mexican International Railroad line.

General Porfirio Cordena, who was

appointed military governor of Coahuila by General Pablo Gonzales during the revolt at Mexico City, and who was re-placed by the Obregonista governor, General Luis Gonzales, is reported to be under arrest at Piedras Negras.

Fernando Lera has been appointed Mexican minister to Sweden. Norway and Denmark, the State Department was advised today, and will proceed to his post by way of the United States.

Mexico City, July 7.—(By A. P.)— Elias L. Torres has left Mexico City after a conference with Provisional President De La Huerta relative to an armistice agreement between the gov-ernment and Francisco Villa, the rebei ARREST GENERAL CORDENA chieftain, who is operating in western Chihushua. He is on his way to Villa's headquarters with the government's decision.
