

LEGION OPPOSES WELDING OF BELL

Indorses Mayor Moore for His Stand Against Tampering With Famous Relic

Mayor Moore was commended last night by the county committee of the American Legion for his refusal to permit the Liberty Bell to be tampered with. It was the monthly meeting of the representatives of the world war veterans' organization, and the resolution was adopted amid great enthusiasm. It was held in the Chamber of Commerce assembly room.

The organization of a strong county committee in this city, as provided in the new state constitution, was informed in a resolution offered by Frank W. Nelson, of Post No. 70. It was urged the posts be requested to vote in favor of the formation of a county committee, which under this new constitution requires a favorable vote of three-fifths of the posts representing at least three-fifths of the entire paid-up membership of the county.
