

RULES AGAINST SCHOOL BAN

Lansing, Mich., July 9.—(By A. P.)—Attorney General A. S. Greenback, in an opinion today, ruled that the proposed amendment to the state constitution designed to abolish parochial schools is contrary to the federal constitution and should not be placed on the ballot in November.
