Roma, 12 luglio.—L'Ammiraglio Americano che controlla la costa fuori la zona di armistizio vicino Spalato, Dalmazia, ha posto fine ai conflitti recentemente avvenuti tra jugoslavi ed italiani nella città di Spalato. Cio' secondo un annuncio semi-ufficiale in data d'oggi. L'Ammiraglio intervenne, con le locali autorità, a ristabilire l'ordine.

Trieste, 12 luglio.—Giunge notizia che un ufficiale americano è stato ucciso nei recenti conflitti avvenuti nella strada, tra croati ed italiani, durante le dimostrazioni dei nazionalisti jugoslavi a Spalato. In detto dimonstrazioni soltanto un'altra vittima è stata rapportata, nella persona di un italiano.

Philadelphia, Pa.—Dopo circa sei anni di permanenza in questa città, durante la quale diede prove di alto intelletto e di funzionario instancabile, il Cav. Uff. Gaetano Pocarodi, Regio Console Generale d'Italia, lascia oggi la direzione del Consolato locale, avendo ottenuto, dietro reiterata insistenza di Patria Governo, un congedo per riprendere dalle fatiche sopportate nella sua delicata missione, specialmente durante la guerra.
