

FATHER HOLAHAN'S SUCCESSOR NAMED

Rev. J. J. Rooney, of St. Philip de Neri, Goes to St. Gabriel's Vacant Post

MADE RECTOR IN 1914

The Rev. John J. Rooney, rector of the Catholic Church of St. Philip de Neri, Queen street above Second, has been transferred to St. Gabriel's, Thirtieth and Reed streets, to succeed the late Rev. James A. Holahan, who died two weeks ago.

Announcement that the Rev. Thomas Buckley, of Our Mother of Sorrows Church, Forty-eighth street and Lancaster street, has been appointed as pastor of St. Gabriel's, Onkview, Pa., was also made here today.

Father Rooney was appointed permanent rector of St. Philip's March 19, 1914, succeeding the Rev. James A. Holahan, who died in April of that year. The church of the Maternity of the Blessed Virgin, Bustleton. His appointment to St. Philip's was made by the late Archbishop Pomeroy.

Father Rooney served successively at St. Veron, Tamaqua and St. Veron, here he was curate for six years. In 1901 he was appointed rector of the church in Bustleton.
