"A post-mortem examination shows that this was a clear case of suicide on the part of the dentist, after he had tried to kill Ignatio Marti and Mrs. Ruth Jackson, a girl who had left the dentist to live with Marti.

"Mrs. Jackson told me this aftermoon at Bellevue Hospital, where she is recovering from a bullet wound inflicted by the dentist, that she understood that Doctor Arenas had killed somebody in Havana, Cuba, before he came to New York.

"Mrs. Jackson, who is a perfectly normal young woman, frankly told me that she had left her husband, Eimer Schultz, several months ago in Toleclocame to New York and lived with Doctor Arenas until about ten days ago, when she left him to go to live with young Marti.
