Sevres, Francia, 10 agosto.—Il tratta-  
to di pace con la Turchia e' stato  
firmato nel pomeriggio di oggi Il Gene-  
rale Hamid Pasha e' stato il primo a  
firmare per la Turchia.

La cerimonia per la firma del tratta-  
to e' stata presieduta dal Primo Mini-  
stro di Francia Millerand. Dopo che i  
tre rappresentanti della Turchia ebbero  
firmato, gli alleati apposero la loro  
firma. I rappresentanti dell'Italia e  
della Grecia firmarono per ultimi. La  
Serbia non era rappresentata.

La cerimonia comprese la consegna  
di tre documenti. Il trattato di pace  
per se stesso, un protocollo Italo-Greco  
ed un protocollo riguardante la zona di  
influenza in Asia Minore.

Roma, 9 agosto.—Una interpellanza  
sui recenti disordini anti-italiani a  
West Frankfort, Ill., e' stata presentata  
all'indirizzo del Conte Sforza, Ministro  
per gli Affari Esteri, dal Deputato  
Giuseppe Gentile, durante la seduta di  
oggi.

L'On. Gentile, prima della sua  
nomina al Parlamento, fu Console in  
Philadelphia ed a capo del Consolato  
Generale di Denver, Colorado. Anche il  
Deputato socialista Caroti, che per  
circa nove anni fu negli Stati Uniti,  
ha presentato analogo interpellanza.

Il Conte Sforza, rispondendo agli  
interpellanti, ha dichiarato che attende  
un rapporto dalla Regia Ambasciata  
Italiana in Washington e non appena  
lo riceverà ne dara' annuncio e  
prendera' i necessari provvedimenti per  
una energica azione.

La scarsita' dei dettagli informativi  
sui fatti di West Frankfort fanno si  
che i giornali siano riservati nei loro  
commenti e si limitano ad esprimere la  
certezza che il Governo Italiano non  
manchera' di domandare al governo  
Americano piena soddisfazione.

Londra, 9 agosto.—La Camera Ita-  
liana dei Deputati ha oggi ratificato il  
trattato di pace tra le nazioni Alleate  
e l'Austria, con voti 170 favorevoli e  
48 contrari. Un emendamento proposto  
dai socialisti fu respinto.

Dopo l'approvazione del trattato la  
Camera si e' agitata fino al 21 ago-  
stembre prossimo, secondo un dispaccio  
giunto alla Exchange Telegraph Co.

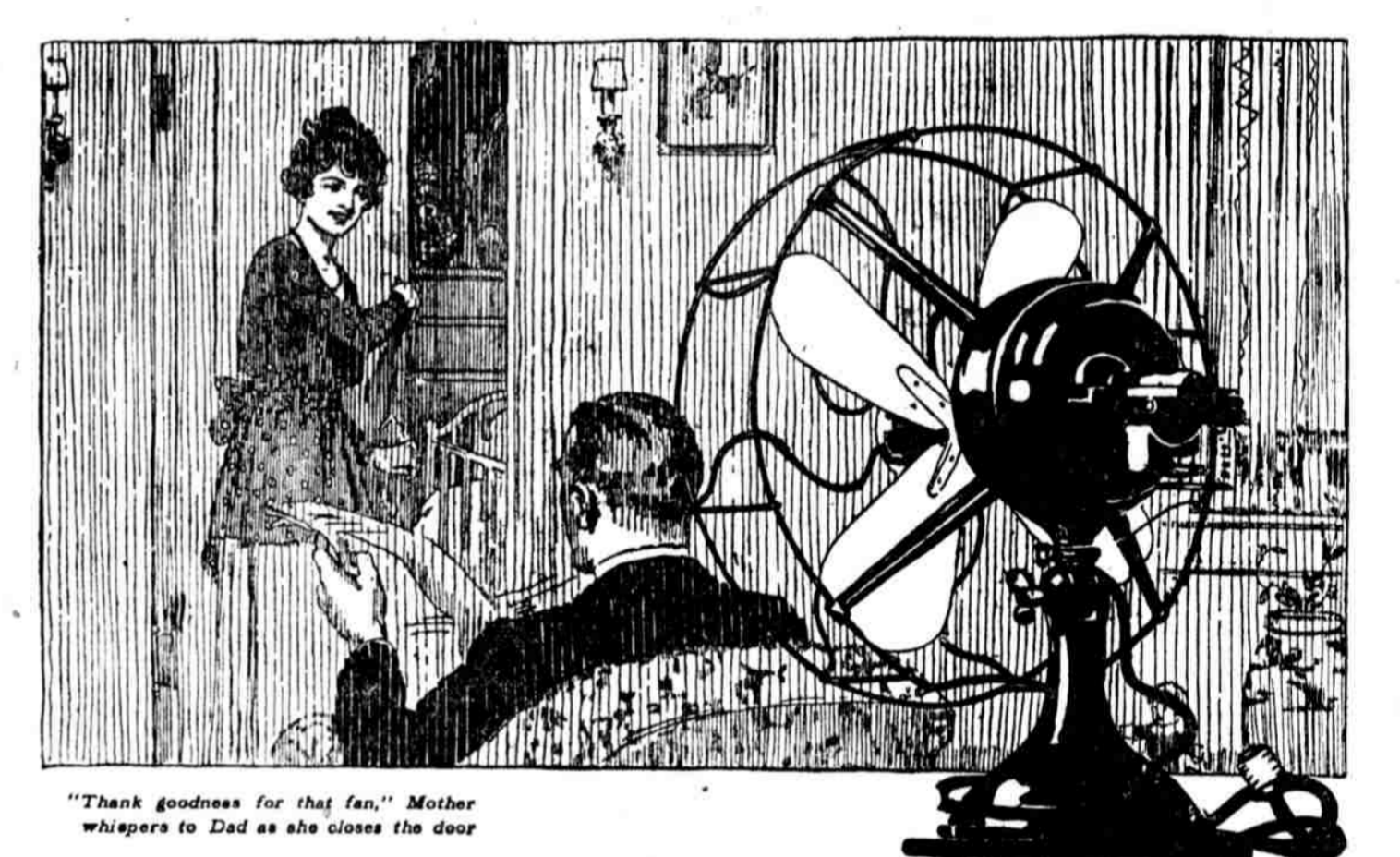

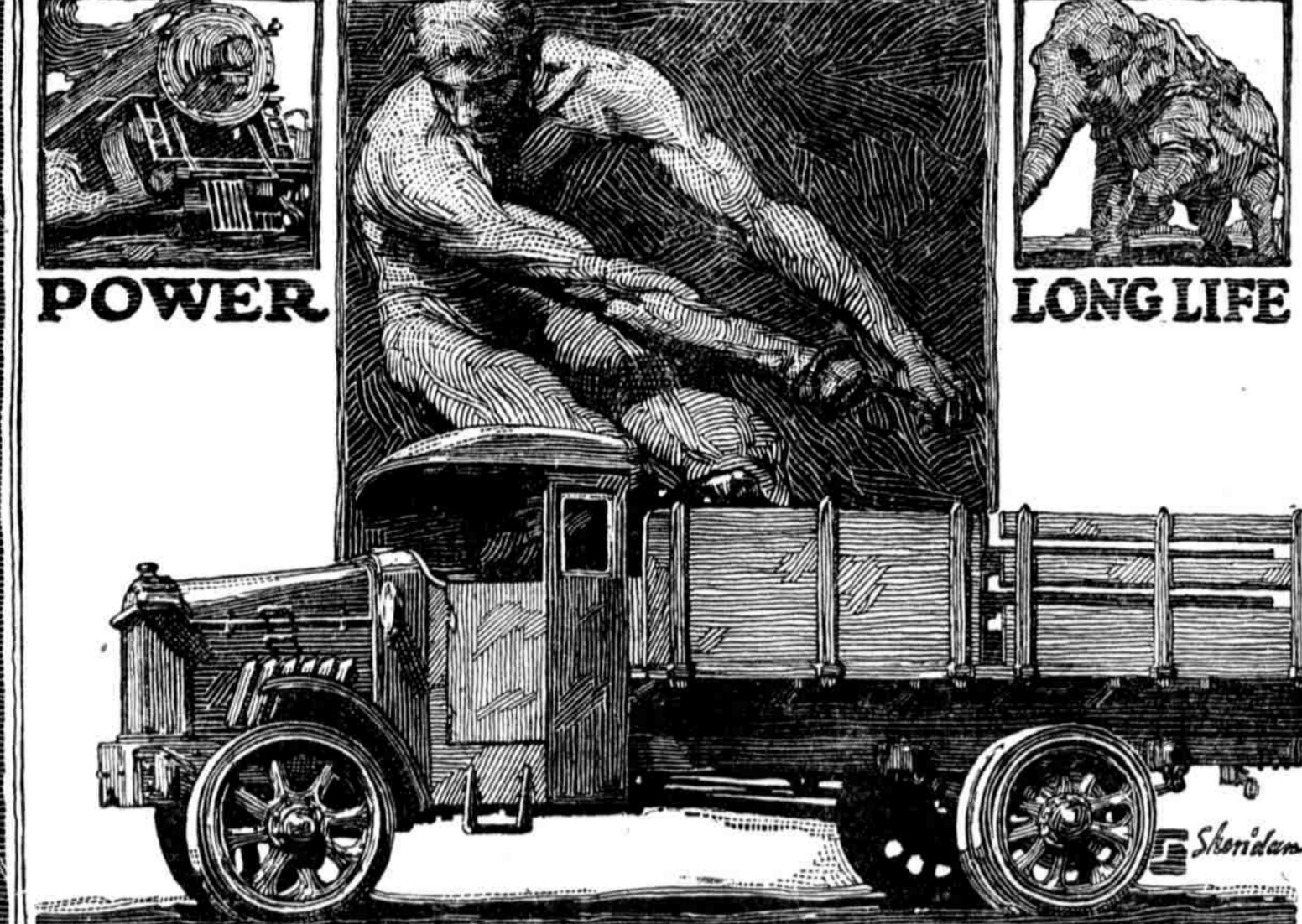
