

LEGION TO CONFER HERE ON SLACKERS
 Commanders Invited to Meeting of Committee at Chamber of Commerce

WANTS MORE ACTIVE WORK

All commanders of posts of the American Legion in this city will be invited to attend the meeting of the Philadelphia county committee in the Chamber of Commerce assembly room, Wednesday evening, when it is expected that action will be taken on the propaganda designed to let off the slackers, draft dodgers and deserters.

It is anticipated that the present county committee will continue in existence possibly until November. Recently it was decided that commanders of posts should be urged to join in the meetings so that posts may be more definitely in touch with the work of the central organization.

While there has been no agitation for a new county committee as provided for in the new constitution, the posts are evidencing an interest in the formation of such a committee.

Breen-McCracken Post, situated in the Forty-fourth ward, is conducting weekly meetings, and will continue to do so. It meets at 3110 Brown street. It has established a business register of all the members.

Errol White, adjutant of the Thomas Robert Reath Marine Post, No. 181, is an advocate of a movement to develop more active workers from among the membership of the posts. He declares that there is an uncountable gap among some of the legionaries.

"I am endeavoring to inculcate a strong post spirit in our post," said Demare White. "I take occasion to emphasize that the marines ought to have the strongest post in the legion in Pennsylvania, and that this goal can be reached if the men will work. We must have the spirit of willingness to help in the legion, if it is to grow as it should and become the power in the community that we hope it will become."

FREE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EX-SERVICE MEN
 Y. M. C. A. Announces Additional Opportunities That Include Any Branch of Schools

Headquarters of the Philadelphia Y. M. C. A. officially announces it is ready to award additional free scholarships to discharged service men. The scholarships are to be had just for the asking.

It is explained in the offer that any former service men interested in taking up a branch of study can start the ball rolling by calling at the central branch, north branch, west branch, south branch or the Germantown branch buildings of the Y. M. C. A.

The scholarships are for any school that is selected by the applicant and for any subject desired. All that the former soldier, former marine or sailor must do is to appear at the instruction office of either of the buildings mentioned with his discharge papers.

There is every opportunity for men who fought for world freedom in France, Germany or Russia, especially the wounded and disabled, to take up some vocational training or if he so desires, to brush up a little on the elementary studies that help so much in life, no matter what a man's pursuit may be. To those who were forced to serve on American soil the same offer applies.

When the International Y. M. C. A. took over the war work from the War Work Council of the American Y. M. C. A., a plan to assist the American service men in helping improve his education was passed on. At once \$1,500,000 was set aside as the original fund for the work in the United States, and \$51,804.74 was placed as the proportion of his money for Philadelphia and environs. Up to today scholarships amounting to \$33,070.00 have been awarded. This leaves a balance of \$18,623.80 that is available for use of the Philadelphia former service men.

Already 623 men have applied for scholarships, 388 of these have had overseas service and sixty-one of them were wounded or disabled.

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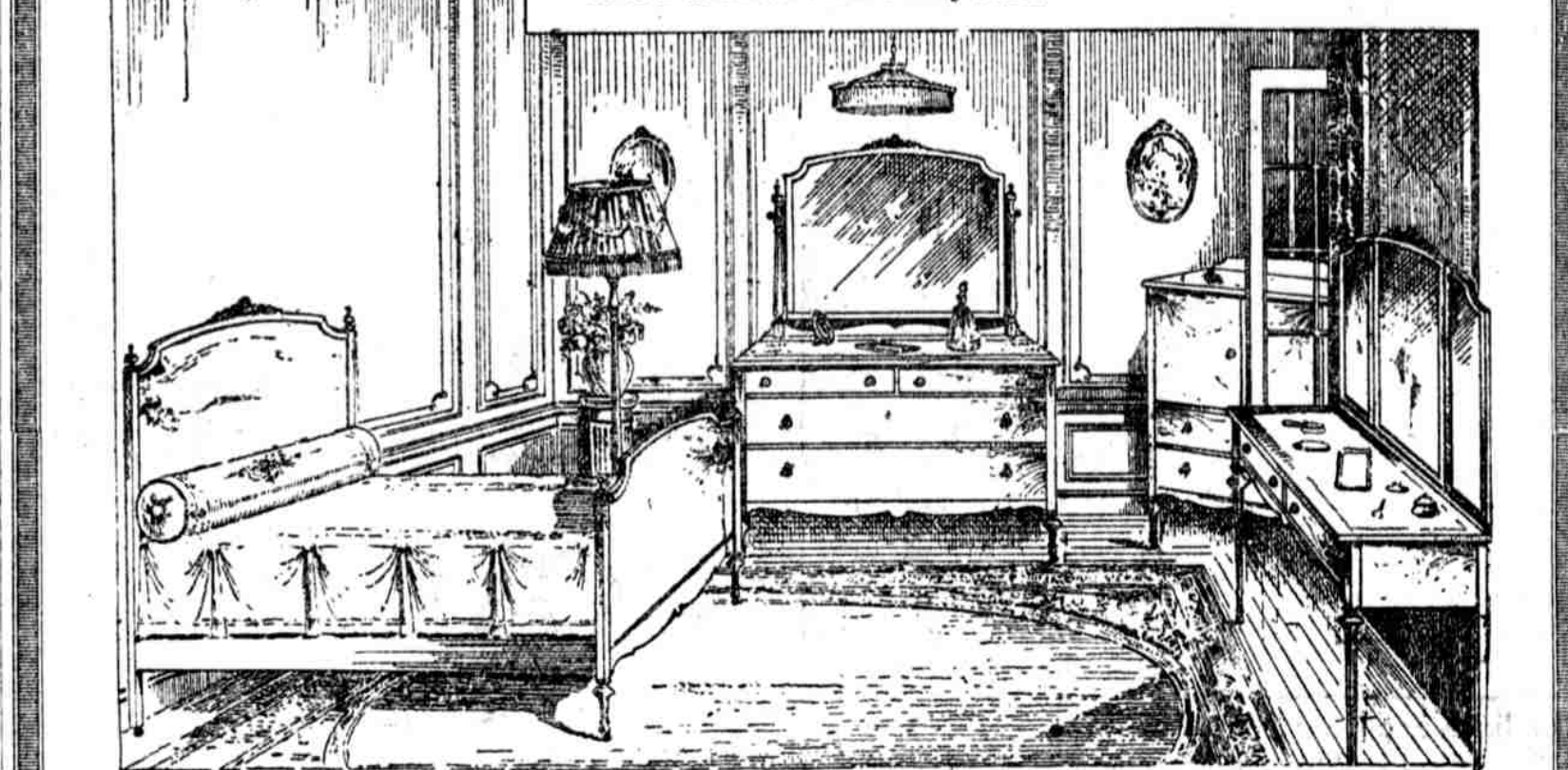
