

ROAD TO NEW YORK OPEN FOR AUTOISTS

Repairs Now Make Pleasant Day Trip Possible, With Enjoyable Stope En Route

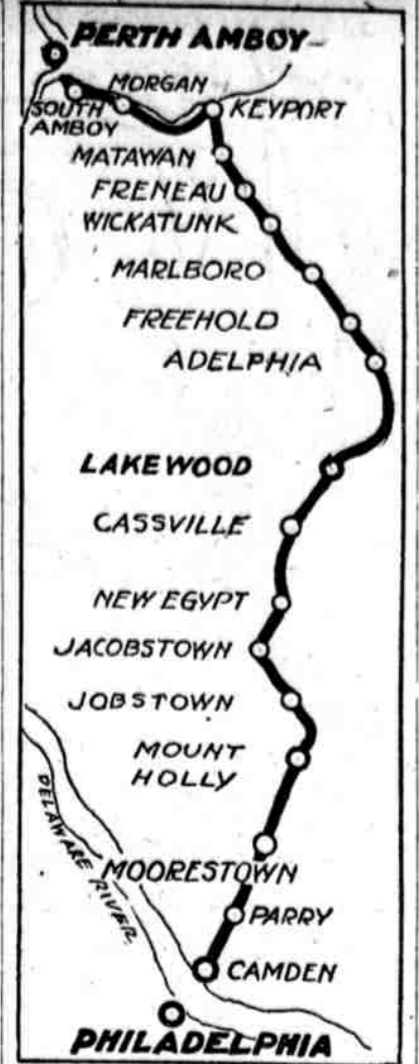
IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE

During the last week several New Jersey roads have been reopened upon the completion of repairs. As a result the trip from here to Perth Amboy via Lakewood is now possible. One motorist on leaving Mount Holly is advised as far as Jacobstown. Then the national highway is followed. The road, with few exceptions on this trip, is in good condition. There are several good stops in Lakewood where the motorist can get over for a while.

At Lakewood the motorist heads directly north passing through Philadelphia, Freehold, Marlboro, Wickatunk, Freehold, Marlboro, Wickatunk, South Amboy and Perth Amboy. The entire trip is a little more than 115 miles and can easily be made in a day. Consequently the trip is ideal for short runs. There are a number of good hotels in Perth Amboy where adequate accommodations may be had. The return trip will have to be through the same towns, because it is not wise to deviate from known roads at the present time in Jersey. The inland scenery is very pretty and should prove charming during the late summer days.
