

**LEGION FUN UNIT
GOING IN BOX CARS**

Societe de 40 Hommes and 8 Chevaux Will Leave Here for National Meeting

Traveling to the American Legion national convention at Cleveland in a special train exclusively of box cars, La Voiture Nationale La Societe de 40 Hommes and 8 Chevaux will provide one of the features of the second great gathering of legionnaires since the world war veterans were organized. The train will leave Broad street station at 7:30 Sunday morning. It was made possible through the interest taken by General W. V. Atterbury, of the Pennsylvania Railroad, a member of the Pennsylvania Railroad Post No. 204.

Members of the 40 Hommes and 8 Chevaux were seeking novelty. The name of the organization is derived from the quaint and comic French designations scrawled on the box cars in which the soldiers traveled in France. They conceived the idea of being transported to the national convention in box cars, and virtually every one said it couldn't be done. But General Atterbury was caught with the idea and cleared the track for this odd pilgrimage.

The 40 Hommes and 8 Chevaux will be headed by Joseph W. Green, whose title happens to be chief de colonie de fer, or, in English, "the boss rail-roader." The train will be scheduled through Pittsburgh, where it will halt long enough to take on additional members and a band. It will reach Cleveland Monday morning in time for the Philadelphia caucus.

Legionnaires enrolled under the banner of the 40 Hommes and 8 Chevaux are staging this unusual "stunt" to impress the national convention with the propriety of establishing this organization as the play organization of the Legion. Franklin D'Olier, national commander of the Legion, joined at the Allentown convention, where it was formed.

Robert J. Martin Post No. 88 held a smoker last night in McPherson Library, Kensington and Indiana avenues, resuming the activities of this post for the fall season. There is a marked interest in the group of veterans, and they anticipate great expansion during the next six months.
