To lend the aspect of a plot it is shown that nothing was taken from the home, while one of the murderers, an artist named Buechner, went into the coal bin of the Von Scheer home and killed himself after he had aided in the assassinations. His companion escaped.

The nurders occured Friday. Buechner and his companion, whose identity is undetermined, approached the villa openly with masks on their faces. They broke into the house in broad daylight, and without a word of warning began to empty their revolvers at the inmutes.

The maid was the first to face the in-truders and she received a fatal bullet, from which she died almost instantly. Then when the other woman rushed to her assistance, the assassins blazed away Mrs. von Scheer fell dead and the daughter dropped unconscious with a bullet in her bedy.
