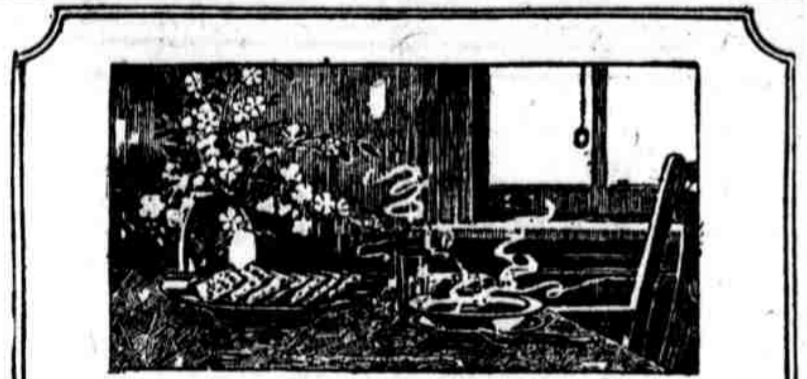


Philadelphia Biographies Ready
