

MAYOR CALLS OFF GAMES ON SUNDAY

Crowds Protest as Police Enforce Law Against Playing for Admission Charge

FREE CONTESTS ALLOWED

Commercialized Sunday sport got a jolt yesterday when the managers of the teams received police orders a few hours before the scheduled contests to call them off.

In each case the postponement cost the management hundreds of dollars in expenses, in addition to the inconvenience caused thousands of would-be spectators who, unaware of the order, flocked to the grounds.

A detail of patrolmen was kept busy at Orthodox and Richmond streets, where the Bridesburg Athletic Association was scheduled to play the Thomas Athletic Association football team from Bethlehem.

Each trolley car brought its load of people, and hundreds of automobiles added to the confusion in traffic. Several accidents were narrowly averted. Those who came to see the game were found in their condemnation of the police order.

Manager Dave Bristow, of the Heidelberg Club, was forced to stand all expenses of the visiting eleven without the compensation of the usual gate receipts. Manager Bristow will hire an attorney to represent his club in the Sunday sports dispute.

Virtually the same scenes were enacted at Sixty-eighth street and Elmwood avenue, where the Vincennes club was scheduled to meet the strong eleven from Riverside, N. J. Manager William MacDonald, of Vincennes, offered to submit to arrest and then fight the matter out in court if the police allowed the game to go on, but his offer was refused.

The Natick baseball team was scheduled to play Joe O'Rourke's big league all stars at Ontario and Miller streets, but the management was notified of the order prohibiting the game.
