

GERMANS OBSERVE SOVIETS' BIRTHDAY

Great Open-Air Mass-Meeting in Berlin With Red Predominating

U. S. PASSPORTS \$2500 EACH

Berlin, Nov. 8.—The Independent Socialists and radicals in the ranks of German workmen who recently pledged allegiance to Moscow, staged an immense celebration on the anniversary of the Russian revolution in the Lustgarten here today.

Red flags, armbands, carnations, neckties and placards bearing the inscriptions "Socialist Russia is free and Long Live the International" were much in evidence.

As the radicals consider that the German revolution was well begun, but has not yet been completed, they will not be granted a national holiday.

Polish Buy U. S. Passports Warsaw, Nov. 8.—American passports, particularly those issued to naturalized citizens, are worth \$2500 to \$3000 in gold in Bolshevik Russia.

As a result naturalized citizens who lose their passports in Poland and the Baltic states are now compelled to wait until Washington approves the issue of new documents.
