

UN ACCORDO TRA ITALIA E JUGOSLAVI

La Scabrosa Questione sull'Adriatico Finalmente Sarebbe Stata Sistemata

Santa Margherita, 10 novembre.—Un accordo tra l'Italia e la Jugoslavia sulla questione dell'Adriatico è stato virtualmente raggiunto. Mr. Trumbich, ministro jugoslavo per gli affari esteri, ha informato i corrispondenti dei giornali che la delegazione jugoslava ha accettato completamente il programma italiano. Domani l'on. Giolitti arriverà qui per segnare il finale accordo. Entrambe le delegazioni partiranno subito, lasciando il lavoro della sistemazione di minori dettagli ad una speciale commissione.

Londra, 10 novembre.—Un dispaccio al Times da Santa Margherita dice che la questione Adriatica è stata sistemata sulle seguenti basi: 1. La frontiera Istriana naturalmente decisa in favore dei jugoslavi; 2. Fiume sarà indipendente con contigua territoriale con l'Italia; 3. Zara sotto la sovranità italiana; 4. Le isole Cherso, Lussin ed Ucie cedere all'Italia. Con riferimento alla frontiera dell'Istria, per la quale vi era divergenza tra i delegati italiani e jugoslavi, il Times dice che è stata accettata la linea stabilita dal patto di Londra con certe rettificazioni. Questa concessione da parte degli italiani, mentre lascia Monte Nevoso all'Italia, evita un accordo di offensivo carattere per la Jugoslavia. L'accordo territoriale sarà accompagnato da un accordo commerciale e probabilmente anche politico.

Secondo i disegni della delegazione jugoslava si decide all'accordo dopo essere rimasta riunita fino alle ore 3 di stamane. Un comunicato dell'Agenzia Stefani dice che la conferenza di Santa Margherita ha semplicemente sistemato la frontiera delle Alpi Giulie e si è agitata senza raggiungere un accordo sulle altre questioni, le quali però saranno discusse domani. La riunione delle delegazioni oggi è durata cinque ore. Si asserisce che la sistemazione della frontiera delle Alpi Giulie è stata fatta con piena soddisfazione dell'Italia, tanto dal punto di vista geografico che militare.

SOVIETS TAKE WRANGLER'S CRIMEAN BREASTWORKS

Perekop Fortifications Guarded the Winter Quarters of "White" Army
London, Nov. 11.—(By A. P.)—The fortified works planted by General Wrangel in the vicinity of Perekop, on the Isthmus leading to the Crimean peninsula, have been occupied by the Bolsheviks, according to an official statement from Moscow received here by wireless today. The statement reads: "We have broken the enemy's fierce resistance and occupied his fortified positions near Perekop. We also occupied Armlansk Bazar."

Former Consuelo Vanderbilt Re-ported Engaged to Frenchman
Paris, Nov. 11.—Rumors current in social circles here most intimate with the Duchess of Marlborough, daughter of the late W. K. Vanderbilt, say that when her final decree of divorce from the duke has been filed she will marry Jacques Balsan, famous French athlete. Her friends assert that matters have been arranged for her to become Madame Balsan as soon as gossip of the divorce blows over. They say the duchess and her alleged fiance-to-be have been good friends since they were introduced during the war, at which time Balsan was a captain in the air service. It is understood that when Mrs. Vanderbilt, during a recent visit to Paris, urged her daughter to choose her next mate from America, the former replied: "My marriage to the English duke was maneuvered by the family. We had nothing in common. If I marry Jacques I shall do so because I love him."
