

### MIDNIGHT PROWLER EJECTED IN BATTLE

**Parish Street Resident Throws  
Out Man He Surprises  
in Dining Room**

### MOTIVE IS STILL IN DOUBT

An intruder in the home of Martin May, at 4383 Parish street, is being held in the West Philadelphia Homeopathic Hospital in a critical condition, following a battle with May early today.

May, a middle-aged man, was awakened about 12:30 a. m. by a noise in the dining room, according to the police. Stumbling downstairs hurriedly, he bumped into a man as he was about to turn on the lights. They grappled in the dark and rolled about the room in a desperate struggle, upsetting the furniture and making a general wreck of it. Finally, as both men rose to their feet May ended the encounter by catching his younger opponent with a stiff uppercut on the jaw, felling him like a log.

May then picked up the intruder, the police say, and threw him out on the pavement. He then telephoned the French and Media streets police station. Patrolman Anglin took the man to the West Philadelphia Homeopathic Hospital, where he was found to have possibly a fracture of the skull. His condition is regarded as serious.

As the victim recovered consciousness for a short time, he gave his name as Thomas Fitzpatrick, thirty-six years old, 4580 Parish street. The police are in doubt as to whether he entered the May home with intent to rob, or got in there by mistake.

May was held for a hearing before Magistrate Price, pending the result of Fitzpatrick's injuries. Later he was released in \$300 bail. He signed his own bond.

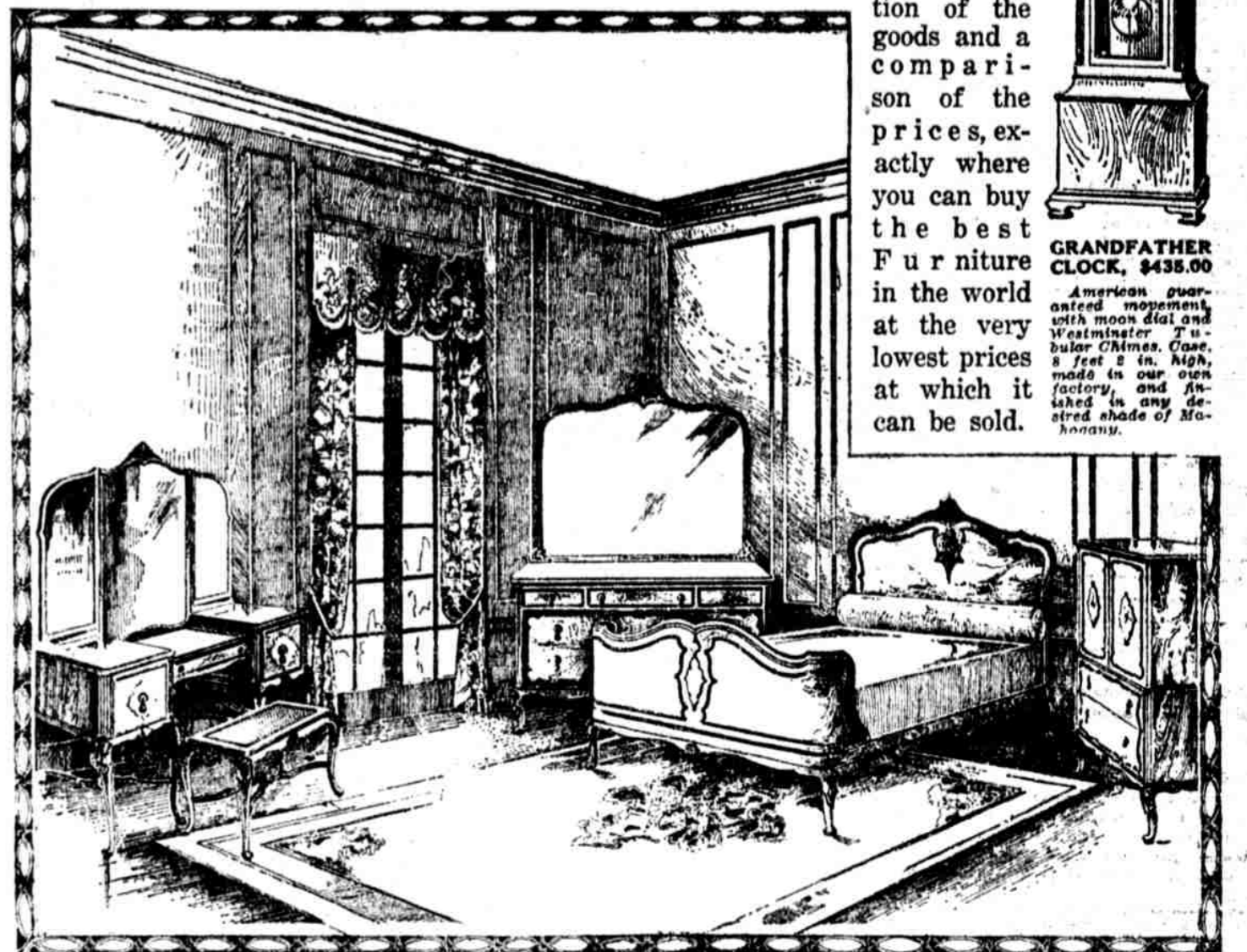
