England and France need not fear the return of Constantine to the Greek throne, as that would not mean any change in the country's foreign policy, said Prince Andreas.

The Messenger points an interview had by the correspondent in Lucerne with former King Constantine, in which Constantine is reported to have said: "My relations with Premier Entente have been good. Divergence in view occurred only over the decision as to the date of the entry of Greece into the war."

"It was not until later when Venizelos developed a fierce hatred against me—the hatred which led to his fall," Constantine said.

"I am sure Italy will not oppose me. I have a great debt of gratitude for Italy for the way I have been treated, both by the government and public opinion."

Paris, Nov. 19.—(By A. P.)—Allied nations probably will intervene to prevent the return of former King Constantine to the Greek throne, says Charles Martel, former French high commissioner in Greece and at present extraordinary French ambassador to the Vatican.
