Patrolman Morrissey found the man crouching under the lean-to, He begged the patrolman to go away and leave The man appeared no worse for his

experience. A few crusts of bread were found in his shelter. Holdt was identified by means of his hospital garments, which bore the name of the Philadelphia Hospital. He was taken to the Manayank police station
