

COLGATE LEFT \$6,000,000

Toilet Goods Magnate Divided Estate Among Family
New York, Nov. 23.—Nearly \$6,000,000 was left by Richard M. Colgate at his death in Orange, N. J., in September of last year. It was learned when the result of the official appraisal of the toilet article manufacturer's estate was placed on file by the deputy state comptroller.

The bulk of the legacy was willed in equal shares to his wife, Mrs. Margaret A. Colgate; his son, Henry A., and his daughter, Muriel Colgate.

Colgate University, of Hamilton, N. Y., was bequeathed \$100,000 and the Samuel Colgate historical collection,

the Orange Orphan Society, the North Orange Baptist Church and Washington Playground in West Orange, received \$25,000 each. The New York Society for the Suppression of Vice, the Orange Memorial Hospital and the Orange Free Library received \$5000 each and the West Orange Visiting Nurses Settlement \$2000.

Building Probers Win Point

New York, Nov. 23.—The joint legislative committee, investigating the alleged "building trust," won the first court test of its powers here last night when Supreme Court Justice Hotchkiss denied a motion to vacate service of a subpoena for Miss Elizabeth O'Dea, an employee of the Builders' Supply Bureau.

U. S. MEDALS TO JAPANESE

Fifteen Are Rewarded for Services During World War
Tokio, Nov. 23.—The American charge d'affaires conferred decorations

on the Japanese minister of marine and fourteen officers for their services during the war.

Washington, Nov. 23.—The negotiations with Japan arising out of the California anti-alien land ownership legislation have not been completed and

no new treaty has yet been "accepted." It was said at the State Department yesterday.

There are indications that the treaty will not be made public before its transmission to the Senate for ratification.

Officials yesterday characterized reports from Tokio of the acceptance of the new treaty as "possibly a little propaganda."

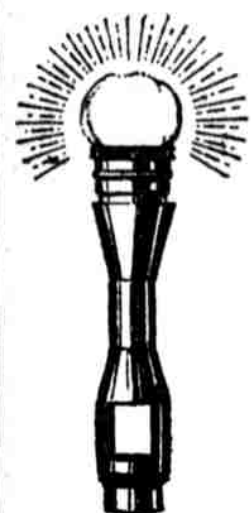

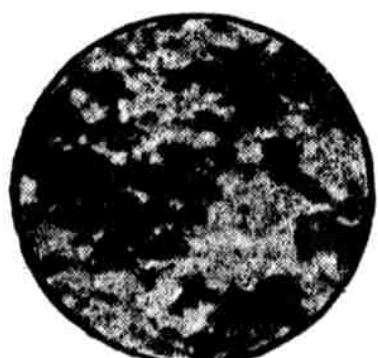

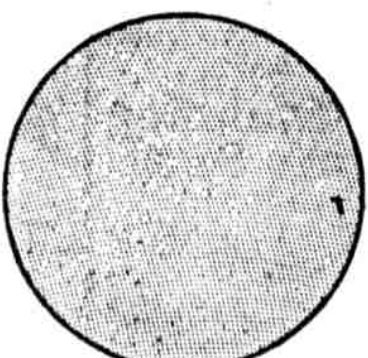
