WANT MORE LAW TEACHERS

U. of P. Appoints Committee to Look for Profes
A special committee on recruiting the teaching branch of the legal profession has been appointed by the Association of American Law Schools. This announcement was made today by Dean Mikel, of the law school of the University of Pennsylvania.

It is the purpose of the committee to keep as full a record as possible of persons who desire to enter upon the teaching of law; to give information as to persons available for law teaching to law school authorities who desire such information.

Prof. Charles K. Burdick, of Cornell University, is chairman of the committee. Other members are: Dean William C. Jones, of the University of California; A. M. Doble, of the University of Virginia; A. M. Thompson, of the University of Pittsburgh; and H. Claude Horace, of the University of Iowa.

TO DISARM WRANGLER ARMY

Troops May Settle in Brazil, Moscow Wireless Asserts
London, Dec. 14.—A wireless dispatch from Moscow today asserts that the troops of General Wrangel, recently driven from the Crimea by the Russian Soviet forces.

General Wrangel, the message reports, has applied to the Brazilian Government requesting permission for a part of his soldiers, "who desire to return to peaceful labor," to settle in Brazil.
