

ONE DEAD, 7 HURT IN AUTO ACCIDENTS

Woman Hit by Motorcar Succumb and Driver Is Held for Coroner

COLLISION ON BOULEVARD

The woman was killed and seven persons were injured in automobile accidents and collisions in the city during the last thirty-six hours.

Mrs. Wilhelmina Smith, sixty-eight years old, 3006 North Twenty-second street, died from injuries received Saturday night when struck by a motorcar at Twenty-first street and Hunting Park avenue. The car was driven by

James Kenderline, of Norristown, who was held without bail to await the action of the coroner. Mrs. Smith died last night in St. Luke's Hospital.

Four persons were injured when two motorcars crashed together on Roosevelt boulevard near Foulkrod street on Saturday night. They are:

Mrs. Joseph Beatty, thirty-nine years old, 4000 Mudgee street, fractured right arm.

Lillie Beatty, eleven years old, her daughter, fractured collarbone.

Miss Margaret McLaughlin, eighteen years old, 7112 Rising Sun lane, fractured right arm.

Edward P. Smith, thirty-five years old, 4824 Penn street.

Smith drove the car which collided with the one in which the woman and two girls were riding.

Smith took the injured to the Frankford Hospital and then surrendered to the police of the Taxco station.

Max Teddlor, Salford street near Woodland avenue, and Lawrence Neideman, 357 North Sixth street, were severely cut and bruised when the car in which they were riding collided with another at Fifty-eighth and Arch streets last night. Teddlor and Frank Lipino, Sixty-first street near Calow-

hill, the driver of the other car, were arrested and a hearing will be given them by Magistrate Price this morning.

George Dean, twenty-two years old, 2036 North Warnock street, was seriously injured by an automobile which struck him last night at Warnock street and Montgomery avenue. He was taken to St. Joseph's Hospital.

WOULD TEACH FOREIGNERS

Night Classes Exclusively for Adults Urged by Dr. Haney

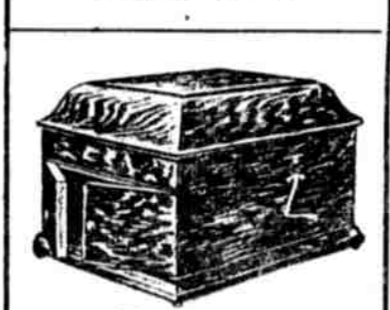

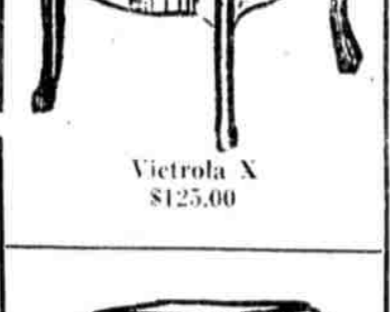
