

D'ANNUNZIO STOPS FIUMANS LEAVING

Poet-Warrior Proclaims State of War Against Italy—Orders Traducers Shot

WIRES INTO CITY ARE CUT

By the Associated Press London, Dec. 23.—D'Annunzio has proclaimed that a state of war exists between his Fiume government and Italy, and has forbidden the population of Fiume to leave the city.

Rome, Dec. 23.—(By A. P.)—To all appearances a state of war has been re-established along the Fiume front. Roads and railway tracks have been torn up, harbors were entanglements have been established and all telephone and telegraph wires leading into Fiume have been cut.

General Cavaglio, commander of government troops around Fiume, has issued a manifesto urging his men to give evidence of their discipline and loyalty. Captain Gabriele D'Annunzio, on the other hand, is launching his appeals. He is praising sailors of Italian destroyers which recently took their ships over to the D'Annunzio side, and is inviting other Italian soldiers and sailors to follow their example.

Trieste, Dec. 23.—By A. P.—Strong columns of carabinieri and Alpine brigades into probably a series of battalions, have been ordered about Fiume and have completely isolated that city by land. The Italian fleet, which has its headquarters at Pola, is scouring the Gulf of Quarnero, and night lights play on the waters from twilight till dawn.

JAPANESE CRUEL IS CHARGE

Soldiers Accused of Slaughtering 145 Koreans and Burning 36 Villages Washington, Dec. 23.—The Korean commission today issued a statement in which it charges Japanese punitive expedition of 20,000 soldiers is accused of having slaughtered 145 Koreans, including men, women and children, and burning 36 villages, following the clash between Korean insurgents and Japanese troops last month.

The Japanese Government's reign of terror in Korea, the statement says, has been carried into southern Manchuria where some 50,000 Koreans have been driven out of their native lands.
