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Roma, 6 gennaio.—Notizie attendibili da Budapest recano come imminente la proclamazione di una monarchia e che i capi politici ungheresi hanno deciso di offrire la corona di San Stefano a l'ex-imperatore Carlo d'Austria. E' pero' accertato che l'Italia strenuamente si oppone ad un tentativo per restaurare gli Asburgo e sara' sostenuta dalla Czecho-Slovacchia, dalla Jugoslavia e dalla Romania. Cio' rappresenterebbe la prima prova di resistenza della "Piccola Intesa" sotto il "leadership" dell'Italia.
