

AGED VETERAN GOES A. W. O. L., THEN LANDS IN HOSPITAL

Lieutenant Charles Brough, 85, Grew Tired of Soldiers' Home Routine and Came to Philadelphia—Has Long War Record

Lieutenant Charles Brough is absent without leave from his station at Kearny, N. J. He eluded the guards about the post and came to this city to see some old friends. On his arrival he became ill and was taken to Roosevelt Hospital where Dr. Franklin P. Brady today diagnosed his case as heart trouble and a slight touch of pneumonia. Lieutenant Brough is recuperating and expects to be discharged in a few days.

It is not probable that Lieutenant Brough will be dealt with severely for though he is not as young as he once was, he is only eighty-five on his birthday. The lieutenant was born on a farm near Second street and Girard avenue, and at the outbreak of the Civil War enlisted in the Twenty-first Pennsylvania Volunteer Infantry. He served three months and was mustered out. He went to Camden and enlisted in the Sixth New Jersey Infantry, in which he served until peace was declared. He served as aide to General Grant and other high officers, and took part in the thirty-six engagements with his regiment. The most notable of these were Fair Oaks, Seven Pines, Williamsburg, Malvern Hill, the Wilderness, Spotsylvania, Fredericksburg, Gettysburg and Chancellorsville.

Previous to his admission to the Soldiers' Home at Kearny he worked for a number of years as an artist's model and has posed for the Academy of Fine Arts and the Plastic Club.
