

MRS. WILSON'S FRENCH LESSON ON HOW MEAT LOAF IS MADE

She Gives Several Recipes for Sauces With Which to Garnish and Serve It—This Can Be Kept for Emergency Use

THE French housewife knows that a large bowl of bouillon in the icebox is always necessary for good menus. She plans many soups and sauces with bouillon as a basis, knowing that they may be quickly prepared.

Do not make the mistake of serving bouillon in a soup plate. Rather serve it in bouillon cups or any dainty cup of thin china—steaming hot and well seasoned.

For variety add one teaspoon of well-washed rice to one quart. Cook slowly until tender.

One-half cup of noodles, broken fine. One-half cup of macaroni, broken fine.

Hard-boiled egg, coarsely chopped. Pimientos, rubbed through sieve.

Two-thirds cup of mushrooms, cut in tiny bits.

One-half cup of string beans, cut in tiny bits.

One-half cup of carrots, cut in tiny threads and parboiled.

One-half cup of finely chopped parsley.

One-half cup of finely chopped celery.

One-half cup of finely chopped onion.
