

WAR TAMES WILD IDEAS AND LIBERAL CLUB ENDS
 Famous Haunt of Radicals in Greenwich Village Bankrupt
 New York, Jan. 21.—(By A. P.)—Greenwich Village's oldest and most popular haunt—the Liberal Club—a gathering place for more than eight years of radicals, playwrights, actor folk, "would-be's" and "has-beens," passed into the discard yesterday.
 Located in McDougall's alley, just off Washington square, the Liberal Club, since its founding by Lincoln Steffens, in which the customs and ideals of Greenwich Village were championed, The Liberal Club entered into its declining days at the close of the war, when some of its members, avowed radicals before they entered the service, came back with different views. This caused a lack of unity and the membership dwindled.
 But the club still had money. It planned a brilliant festival, "the blitz," which later was held. It was a success artistically, but a cataclysm financially.
 The landlord came. He was offered the radiators which had kept new ideas warm, and the electric fixtures, which had illuminated wild Apache dances and bitterly-fought bridge games, and he took them.
 A ten shop will be opened in the clubrooms. "Faithful" members still may have use of a cubby hole in one corner.
