OFF from the world by snow and ice, several hundred men in distant Canadian forests are chopping iown trees from which CHICAGO

on the north shore of the Gulf of St. Lawrence, far down toward Labrador, THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE is carrying out a great work of pioneering and development. 

Dams have been built, flooded out and **rebuilt**; a power house has been constructed. washed away and rebuilt; docks have been torn to pieces while under construction, bur others have taken their places. Setbacks and discouragements have been
