IT WAS rumoured yesterday that Harry Gowdy, catcher for the Boston Braves, was about to be placed on the market and traded to the club which offers the best in documents. This means full players will be accepted in stead of money to complete the transaction.

The other active athletes, Alexander and Kelleher, are with Chicago. Pfeifer was traded to the Indians to finish his career. Whittier is in Pittsburgh, Shantz in St. Louis and Bannister in New York. Sam Payne, the ground keeper, is the old survivor.

Connie Mack's team, still in existence, is making and marking good on different paths. The team which started under the steamer Edmon Chaffee is now under the steamer Joseph L. Walsh. The New York Americans, who were the best in the country in 1914, are now under the charge of Alvin Dark. The team which started under the name of the same old Joe Bush, Heath Parsons and Harry McInnis are employed by the Boston Red Sox. Shantz and Wally Schaeffer will manage in New York. Bill Keeler shortstop for Cincinnati and Elmer Bender is now back in New Haven, Conn.

Frank Baker probably and reasonably thinks we are making a total of eleven of the 1914 champs, nothing more or less.

THIS has been known for a long time, but was never so openly acknowledged as at the present moment. The Philadelphia and Boston teams are worth the same amount. The two had approximately the same record.
