

WOMAN'S NERVE DEFENDS SALOON

Courage Inspires Bartender to Fight Raiders of Callowhill Street Cider Bar

BARTENDER SHOT IN LEG

The courage of a woman, wife of a saloon keeper, and the fierceness of her husband, who attacked three armed bandits and rescued a bullet wound in the leg last night saved the contents of the cash register from falling into the hands of the robbers and brought about the arrest of one robber.

The woman is Mrs. Doris Diamond, of 619 Callowhill street. She and her husband, Max Diamond, of 618 North Eleventh street.

The saloon was crowded and Diamond was busy dealing out drinks when the three men entered. One came from the door while the other two stood motionless in different ends of the saloon. At a signal from the man standing near the door, the others drew revolvers and the man at the door ordered all to stand still. He then turned and went around the bar.

One of the men then ordered the crowd to make an opening and as they did he commanded the bartender to open the cash register and bring over the dough. Diamond hesitated a few moments and the bandit then pointed his revolver at the bartender's head and said:

"Come across and come quick."

Just then Mrs. Doris Diamond, the saloonkeeper's wife, stepped into the barroom and, sitting on the situation, said:

"What's the job, boys? Get away the toy pistol. The third hand, described as about eighteen years old, wheeled about and pointed the gun at her and told her to keep quiet. Mrs. Diamond laughed at the bandit and taunted him, telling him he was afraid to shoot as the shot would attract the police."

Bartender Attacks

Mrs. Diamond's courage put some age into the bartender and when the bandits again ordered him to give up the money in the cash register, he leaped the bar and attacked one of the bandits, who broke loose from Diamond and fired his revolver, the bullet lodging in the bartender's left leg.

The firing of the shot frightened the bandit at the door and the one who threatened to shoot Mrs. Diamond. The two men ran from the saloon and escaped by running west on Callowhill street. The bandit who did the shooting then backed against the wall and said, "Who's next? The first man that moves gets the same medicine. Come up now. Come across with what you got."

FALL ON STAIRS KILLS MAN

John Lawson, Accident Victim, Says Detective Belshaw

Falling down a flight of stairs at his home last night, John Lawson, aged fifty-six years, of 4936 Thompson street, suffered injuries that resulted in his death.

Lawson had gone upstairs about 10 o'clock, telling his wife he was going to retire. About fifteen minutes later she was startled by a crash and, running into the hallway, discovered her husband lying at the foot of the steps in a pool of blood. The injured man was taken to the West Philadelphia Homeopathic Hospital, where he was pronounced dead.

Detective Belshaw, of the murder squad, was notified and he conducted an investigation. Later he announced the man had died as the result of an aortic aneurism.

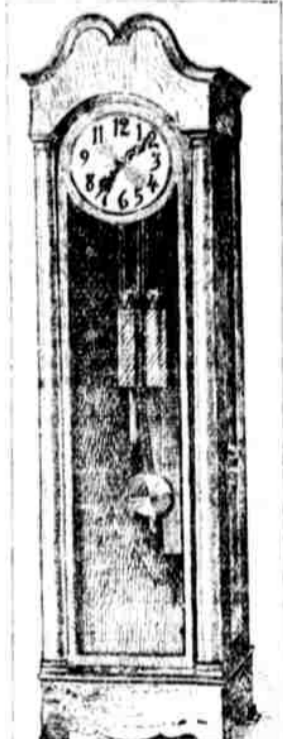

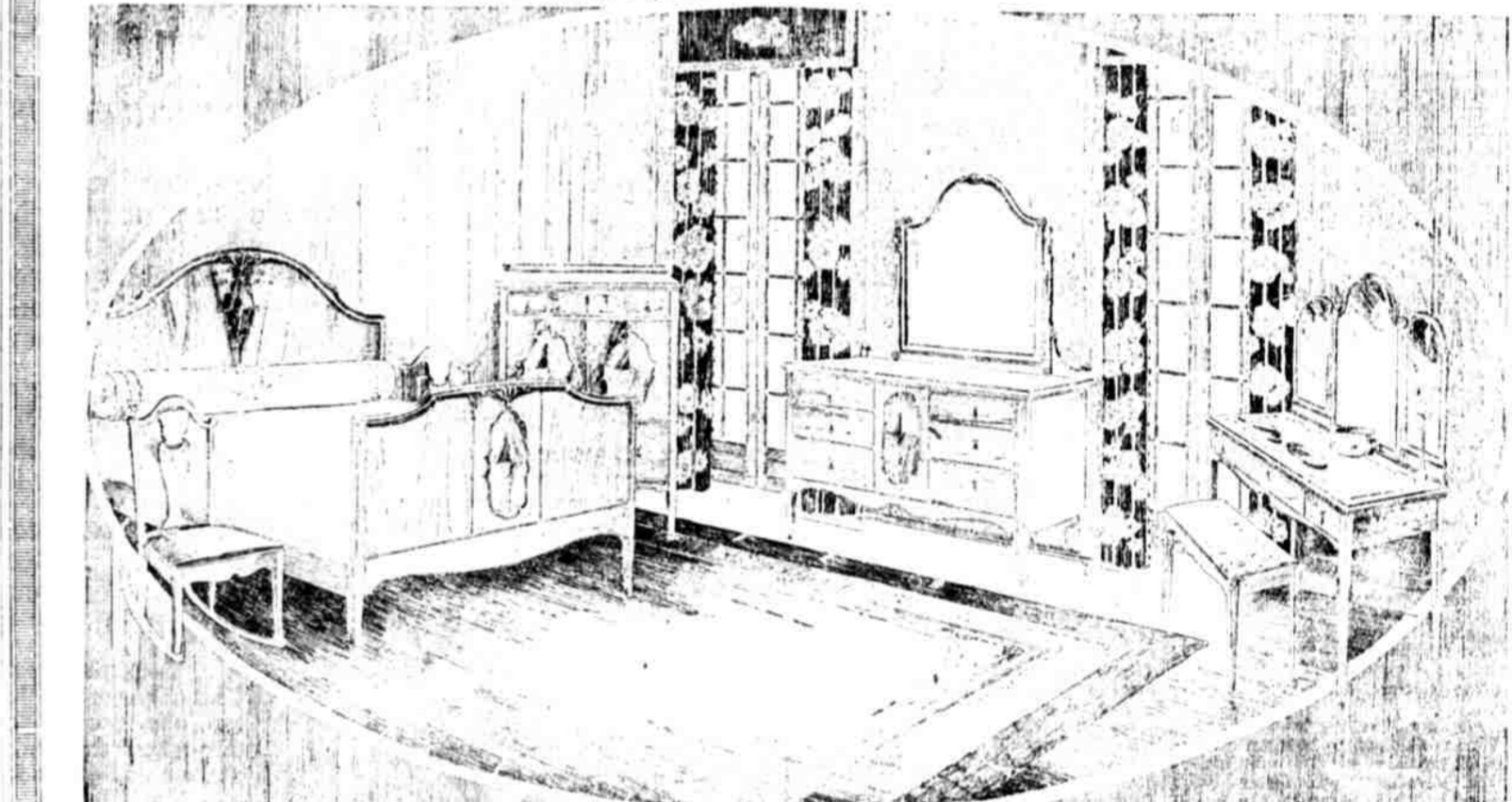
