

# GIOLITTI OTTIENE IL VOTO DI FIDUCIA

## La Camera Approva la Politica del Governo con 226 Voti Favorevoli e 79 Contrari

Roma, 4 febbraio.—La Camera dei Deputati, ieri, ha dato un voto di fiducia al Governo per la sua politica interna. La mozione che implicava tale fiducia riportò 226 voti favorevoli al gabinetto Giolitti e 79 contrari.

L'on. Giolitti, allora, ne fece questione di fiducia. L'ordine del giorno scisso in due mozioni l'una riproponendo l'azione delle locali autorità nei luoghi ove avvennero i recenti conflitti tra socialisti e fascisti e l'altra condannante la politica del Governo.

Roma, 4 febbraio.—Il voto di fiducia concesso al Governo dimostrò che tutti i partiti, ad eccezione dei socialisti e dei nazionalisti estremisti, hanno approvato la politica dell'on. Giolitti, la quale mira alla sistemazione dell'ordine gradualmente ed al rispetto assoluto della legge senza ricorrere a reazione o violenza.

### URGES BRITAIN MEDIATE

Australian Paper Says London Should Smooth Japan-U. S. Troubles

Sydney, Feb. 4.—It has been stated here that the Japanese crown prince, in making a visit to Great Britain, has two objects in view, the first being to express the Japanese desire to renew the Anglo-Japanese alliance and the second to discuss limitation of naval armament. The Sydney Herald, in commenting on the crown prince's trip, says: "The three chief naval powers in the world are close enough together to compare on this misunderstanding before it grows any more serious. Great Britain as Japan's ally in the event of an Anglo-American quarrel would be unthinkable. The empire would not survive such a disaster. Since Great Britain is on such intimate terms with the two powers concerned in the latest international difference, she surely is capable of smoothing the way for reconstruction."

### "PINK" ANARCHIST MUST GO

Russian Writer, Philosophic Radical, Loses Deportation Appeal

New York, Feb. 4.—Anarchism, be it philosophic or otherwise, can be taught but anarchism, and he who upholds its doctrines has no place in the United States, Judge Charles M. Hough, of Federal Court ruled yesterday. He dismissed the writ of habeas corpus filed by Alexis Georgiann, mild Russian radical, who was ordered deported after arrest in Minneapolis recently, charged with advocating the overthrow of the government by force.

Georgiann, in his literature and teachings maintained he was but a "philosophic anarchist" and as such did not advocate force in overthrowing the government.
