

LEGION SUPPORTS KENYON MEASURE

Service Men's Organization, Through Weekly Paper, Advocates Training Bill

WOULD ASSIST WIDOWS

Enactment of the Kenyon bill by the House of Representatives would benefit half of the 294,000 disabled former service men who had registered for training with the Federal Board of Vocational Training, December 18, and also would extend the privileges of training to Americans disabled in allied armies during the war and to widows and children of veterans who died in the service.

That declaration is in an article in the current issue of the American Legion Weekly. The Kenyon bill has been passed by the Senate and awaits action of the House.

Claims of half the disabled world was veterans were disabled because of the rating that a disability rating of 10 per cent was a prerequisite to training.

359 a Month
Widows of veterans, not remarried, would be entitled under the Kenyon bill to enter training any time until 1925, and children at any time between the ages of fourteen and sixteen. The bill would benefit 25,000 widows and as many children would be eligible. Compensation of fifteen months would be paid during training. Passage of this legislation was urged at the Cleveland national convention of the Legion.

Mrs. Theodore W. North, of the ladies auxiliary of Thomas Robert North (Marine) Post, states that the loyal cooperation of the war mother, and sisters of the Marine Corps League has been promised the newly organized auxiliary. Nineteen out of twenty-five of these mothers lost their sons in the world war.

"We urge," adds Mrs. North, "that all women members of the families of the Marines of the post join the auxiliary promptly, so that we may have the honor of making an auxiliary a leader in this great movement. The duties involved by joining will be chief and foremost to stand steadfast to the Legion, further the interests of the post in promoting a general good spirit among the families of the post and to spread influence generally for the service and the Legion."


