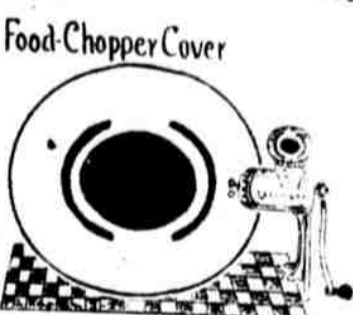
IT WAS quarter of eight in the evening when their conversation, an important one about some church work, started.
