Penrose to Hear Governor Sproul and Leader Crow in Washington

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conferences the Governor plans to arrange to start his bill for submitting to the people the question of calling a constitutional convention and to decide upon ways and means of increasing the revenues.

One of the Governor's proposals, made in his message to the Legislature, is that a small tax be laid on the capital stock of manufacturing corporations. This is vigorously opposed by the allies of Joseph R. Grandy, president of the Pennsylvania Manufacturers' Association.

On the other hand Governor Sproul feels that it is up to the Legislature to select new taxes out of the legislation proposed by himself and members of the Assembly.

It is his disposition, because of the harassing activities of the "grundy men," to push the tax on manufacturing corporations. This is one of the big subjects which will be discussed in the conference.

It is possible, therefore, that Mr. Grandy, who has been conferring frequently with Senator Penrose at Washington in regard to both state and national revenue legislation, will be within hailing distance when his opponents, the Governor and state chairman, are in Washington.

The impression prevails among legislative leaders that Senator Penrose will leave the question of revenue to the Sproul-Crow leadership after pointing out the desirability of having harmony and bringing up the action of the Governor of New York in cutting \$75,000,000 from the state's budget at one stroke.

An indication of his attitude was seen in this comment by Senator Penrose: "I am not taking any active part in Pennsylvania politics."

And leaders of the Vore-Brown-Cunningham combination, who are working under Senator Penrose, and who control a majority of the big Philadelphia delegation, said today that the delegation would stand by the Governor. In the opinion of politicians, all these points indicate that a harmonious program for the wind-up of the Legislature is in the making, and that this program will be known as the Sproul-Crow program.
