FIGHT OVER BEER RULING

Special Deputies to Executive Public Ledger Trenton, March 14.—Governor Edwards announced today that he would appoint, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 30 of the new public utility bill, recently passed over his veto, to the Senate the following names for membership of the new board: James A. Hammill, of Hudson, former assemblyman and congressman for twelve years, whose term only recently expired; Joseph S. Hoff, of Mercer, former chief justice commissioner, president of the National Bank of Princeton and also of the Princeton Savings Bank; Harry Bacharach, of Atlantic City, twice mayor of Atlantic City and president of the Marine and Trust Co. and director in several other mercantile institutions.

Two of the men named are Democrats and the other a Republican. The term of the commission is four years, and Commissioner Hoff for four years, and Commissioner Bacharach for the two-year term.
